

To submit written testimony on the Board of Park Commissioner's public hearing for **Elliott Bay Water Taxi to Provide Year-Round Service**

- On **February 26, 2009**, the Board of Park Commissioners will hear a briefing on a proposal for the Elliott Bay Water Taxi to Provide Year-Round Service. The meeting will be held at Park Headquarters at 100 Dexter Avenue North. The written briefing paper will be available on February 20 at the Board's web page, <http://www.seattle.gov/parks/parkboard/>.
- At its **March 12** meeting, the Board will hold a public hearing on the proposal. You may sign up before the public hearing, beginning at 6:00 pm, to give up to **two** minutes of testimony during the public hearing. **Note:** This meeting will be held at West Seattle Golf Clubhouse, 4600 35th Avenue Southwest.
- At its **March 26** meeting, the Board will discuss the proposal and make a recommendation to the Superintendent. This meeting will be held at Park Headquarters at 100 Dexter Avenue North.

You may also submit written testimony for the Board's consideration until the March 26 discussion and recommendation via e-mail, fax, U.S. mail, or hand delivery. The Board does not accept telephone testimony.

All testimony should be sent to Sandy Brooks, Park Board Coordinator, who will forward it to the Board members and to Paula Hoff, Seattle Parks and Recreation Strategic Advisor. Please send your testimony as early as possible to allow the Board adequate time to read.

Written testimony sent to the Park Board receives the same consideration as verbal testimony given at the public hearing.
